Nigeria is the biggest market for used cars in Africa, and is also one of the most affluent in the Sub-Saharan region.

Lagos is among the top ten of the world's fastest-growing cities and has the fourth-highest GDP in Africa at \$145.1billion.

Nigeria alone spends over \$12bn annually on vehicle parts importation

Nigeria's roads constitute of over 95% used cars

DID YOU KNOW?

An astounding 60% of cars on Nigeria's roads are more than 12 years old and only 11% are under five years old - it is estimated that the country's used cars outnumber new cars by 131 to 1 on the road, therefore creating a HUGE demand for car parts.
